The seminar was attended by 1595 delegates from Primary, Manufacturing, Service and Water sector including Scientists, Experts, Policy makers, Beneficiaries, Bureaucrats, Bankers, Markets Producers and NGOs. Hon'ble Minister of Agriculture, Agriculture Education and Research, Shri Surya Pratap Shahi inaugurated the seminar with key presence of Shri Kunwar Manvendra Singh, Chairman, Bundelkhand Development Board, Dr. U.S. Gautam, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, BUAT and other dignitaries.

### EDP on Goat Farming

Department of Agricultural Extension, College of Agriculture organized 5 days Entrepreneurship Development Programme on Goat Farming from February 18<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2020. The EDP was conducted under SC-ST Sub Plan Scheme of ICAR, New Delhi. The programme was designed such a way that the aspiring entrepreneurs equip themselves with Managerial, Financial and Entrepreneurial skills along with Domain specific skills. The twenty participants were selected for the programme on the basis of their interest and need. The participants were comprised of twelve men and eight women



farmers from Banda district. Dr. Mayank Dubey, Assistant Professor (LPM) has delivered lectures on feed and nutrition, and housing management, however, Dr. Manvendra Singh, SMS (Animal Science) explained health and disease management; and reproductive management, etc. Dr. P.K. Ojha, Assistant Professor (Agril. Extension) conducted a session on entrepreneurship development and management. An exposure visit to ICAR-IGFRI, Jhansi was also conducted during the programme. On the closing day of programme, twenty units of *Bundelkhandi* goats (one male and two females per unit) were distributed to each participant. Hon'ble Vice Chancellor advised farmers to start value addition products of goat meat and milk for profitable goat farming. He was the Chief Guest of valedictory function. Dr. G.S. Panwar, Dean, CoA said that goat farming is suitable for Bunelkhand Region and it provides assured income to the farmers. Dr. B.P. Mishra, HoD (Agril. Extension) proposed vote of thanks. ### **Wildlife Day Celebration**

The wildlife conservation is embedded in the Constitution of India. So, it becomes our duty and responsibility to conserve and preserve our flora and fauna and natural ecosystems. Wildlife day was organized by College of Forestry on March 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020. During the event organized by Dr. Aishwarya Maheshwari, Assistant Professor, Wildlife Sciences, CoF along with Dr. Sanjeev Kumar, Associate Dean and faculty members of the CoF, the students of the university were briefed about the value of wildlife. An awareness cum voluntary blood donation camp was organized in collaboration with District Blood Bank office, Banda on March 4<sup>th</sup>, 2020 in the multipurpose hall of College of Agriculture, BUAT. ### **District level farmers' training organized under MIDH**

A One Day district level farmers' training on 'Scientific Cultivation of Spices in Bundelkhand' was organized by Department of Agriculture Extension on March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Banda. The training programme was funded by Directorate of Arecanut and Spices Development (MoA&FW), Calicut, Kerala under Centrally Sponsored Scheme-Mission of Integrated Development of Horticulture. The programme was inaugurated by Dr. G.S. Panwar, Dean, CoA as Chief Guest. He encouraged the farmers to grow different location specific spices crops for fetching more remunerative prices in comparison to traditional crops.



## World Forestry Day Celebration

The World Forestry Day was organized on March 21<sup>st</sup> 2020 at CoF. This event was organized by Dr. Dinesh Gupta, Dr. Bhalendra Singh Rajput, Dr. Chandrakant Tiwari and Dr. Avanish Sharma in the leadership of Dr. Sanjeev Kumar, Associate Dean, CoF. The other faculty members of CoF accompanied the event. Dr. G.S.Panwar, Registrar, BUAT was invited as special guest for the event. He planted a seedling of *Saraca asoca*, State tree of Uttar Pradesh in the premises of CoF. The issues of global warming and role of forest to combat the adverse effects of climate change were addressed.

## Activities under BUAT Kisan-PRAGATI initiative

University committed to work constantly for improvement of agricultural practices of the region. Experts team of 100 village programme visited various villages such as Ludhora, Durendi, Luktara, Pathari and Jaari etc. and interacted with farmers to find out the location specific problems. The experts had a discussion with the farmers about the important interventions such as seed health, seed treatment with chemicals and biofertilizers, management of weeds, management of insect and diseases, sowing techniques etc. They sensitize farmers on integrated farming system, use of biofertilizers and fungicide. The vegetable seeds and flowering plants were also provided to the farmers for upcoming season.

## Integrated Farming System Unit

The performance of various components established in Integrated Farming System (IFS) unit was satisfactory under dryland conditions of Bundelkhand region. Chickpea and mustard in rabi season, okra, pumpkin, muskmelon, bottlegourd, maize observed as the most suitable crops. Similarly, Guinea grass, napier, berseem and sorghum for fodder, citrus family orchard, marigold flower, *Nagendra* poultry, *Bundelkhandi* goat, *Khaki Campbell* duck performed better. Various dignitaries visited to IFS unit viz., Shri Surya Pratap Shahi (Hon'ble Minister-Agriculture, Agriculture Education and Agriculture Research, Govt. of U.P.), Dr. K.V. Raju (Economic advisor of Govt. of U.P.),

Dr. Mangala Rai (Ex. Secretary-DARE and Director General -ICAR, New Delhi), Dr. Bijendra Singh (Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, NDUAT, Kumarganj and DG-UPCAR), Dr. A.S. Panwar (Director-ICAR-IIFSR, Meerut). All the dignitaries have appreciated the work done in IFS unit and also gave the valuable suggestions for improvement and dissemination of IFS among farmers of the Bundelkhand region.

## Awareness on COVID 19 and safety issues

In light of outbreak of COVID 19, as per the direction of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, BUAT, urgent action and initiatives were taken by all the university authorities Registrar, Director Research, Director Extension, DAM, Deans of CoA, CoH and Associate Deans of CoF, CoHSc, and ADSW. The guidelines released by Govt. of India and Govt. of U.P. were strictly followed in the university. The area wide sanitization programme implemented by the respective authorities in entire campus. All the field labourers, mess staff were trained by Dr. B.S. Rajput and Mr. K.S. Tomar about COVID 19 and the masks, gloves and hand sanitizers were also distributed to them. Awareness among students including NSS volunteers were made through presentations and informal interaction by Dr. Dinesh Gupta and Dr. Chandrakant Tiwari.

## Establishment of Plant Tissue Culture Laboratory

BUAT, Banda has developed plant tissue culture laboratory in CoF with the help of RKVY, DARE, U.P. Being an agrarian-based economy, we need to streamline our expertise in the fields of biotechnology and innovation to improve our



agricultural proficiency. Therefore, awareness among the youths and the villagers in respect to technical and entrepreneurial skill to take up self or wage employment in the broad fields of agriculture, industry, services and business activities. The objective of establishment of this laboratory is designed to equip the unemployed rural youth with marketable skills, which would enable them to secure placement in the industry or to pursue sustainable self-employment. The technology will be useful for creating large amounts of plant material through micro-propagation for research/distribution to the farmers. It would also be helpful in conservation of germplasms. It will be initiated by offering the

banana tissue culture plants at various stages of development e.g., culture plants, ex-agar/ bare root plants, net pot plants, hardened plants. The success of plant tissue culture industry is based on the availability of skilled manpower. Therefore, industry specific plant tissue culture based vocational training will be provided to fresh graduates/post graduates to produce trained employable manpower to cater the needs of micro-propagation industry. Awareness campaign will be executed among the farmers on the benefits of tissue cultured plants versus conventionally developed plants. The farmers will also be trained about package of practices for cultivation of tissue cultured plants.

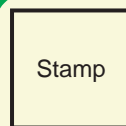
